In Today's Readings: The Prayer of the Church Is the Voice of Faith
Jesus catechizes His disciples in the way of faith by teaching them how to pray. He
promises us: "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be
opened to you" (Luke 11:9). If earthly fathers know how to give good gifts to their
children, "how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him"
(Luke 11:13). Thus, father Abraham was bold in his prayer because he believed the
gracious promise of the Lord, that he would "surely become a great and mighty nation"
(Gen. 18:18). When we pray in Jesus' name, we also hold "fast to the Head" (Col. 2:19),
"rooted and built up in him and established in the faith" (Col. 2:6-7).

POSTLUDE

OUTREACH THOUGHT: Luke 11:1-13: How often have you stood before a full table or before a gathering of people and everyone looks at each other but no one wants to be the one to pray? Prayer is not a natural inclination of those who are sinful by nature and sinful in thought, word and deed. We need to be taught how to pray because prayer is so often seen as only an emergency measure, or a desperate attempt to get a higher power to act on our behalf when we're in trouble. One of the best ways we can share the Good News is by demonstrating a prayer life that reflects an honest communication with God; the ability to, in times of celebration and in times of need, to speak with God as a child speaks to their dear father. That's what Jesus taught His disciples and that's what we can share when we openly pray throughout the day letting the whole world know that before we do anything, we talk to God first in prayer.
